If you had routine cataract surgery, you may start your eyedrops in the operative eye **as soon as you return home**. (If you had combined cataract and glaucoma surgery, or just glaucoma surgery, do not start your eyedrops until your doctor instructs you to do so.) Continue any other drops you may be using in the other eye, as instructed by your doctor. Continue any glaucoma drops unless otherwise instructed by your doctor.

When you use eyedrops, wait 5-10 minutes between the different drops; don't put one in right after the other. Call the office if you are unsure about how to use your eyedrops.

Bring all of your eye medications to the office on each visit.

Use the following eyedrops in the operative eye:

VIGAMOX



One drop, 4 times per day until further notice.

ECONOPRED PLUS



SHAKE BOTTLE WELL BEFORE USE!
One drop, 4 times per day until further notice.

NEVANAC



One drop, 4 times per day until further notice.
